1. The major topic for the BPhF 2017 is set "Collaboration between Pharmacists and Physicians as the base of an effective therapy" and for it will join lecturers from different EU countries and as well from the Baltic states;
2. Website of BPhF 2017 will be launched on first weeks of December, it will also include online registration, however the payment may be only done by direct transaction to Pharmacists' Society of Latvia bank account, receipt will be provided if requested;
3. Participation fee will be as previous years – not more than 100 EUR, which will include full participation (3 days), accommodation (2 nights), meals mentioned in the agenda and other activities. There will be available discounts for students.
4. The total number of students is limited to 10 students per country (including students with poster);
5. Novelty this year! We are expanding our audience with hospital pharmacists! During the Pre-Forum symposium (April 28) there will be a conference devoted to hospital pharmacists (information included in agenda). We invite hospital pharmacists to also take part in the main day of BPhF 2017 (April 29), as well as other pharmacists take part in Pre-Forum conference of hospital pharmacists.
